OPERATION AED

Out of hospital cardiac arrest accounts for 250,000-350,000 sudden cardiac deaths per year in the United States. Research shows that programs based on CPR plus defibrillation with AED's , by trained non-healthcare professionals, offers a survival advantage over CPR only, in out-of-hospital cardiac arrest. (*)

Operation AED was established in memory of Spc. Damon Winkleman (US Army Medic). Damon was a life time member of St. John Lutheran Church McZena who was killed in service to our country in 2009. St. John Lutheran Church Young Adults are dedicated to honoring his memory by installing AEDs within our community.

The goal is to get AED devices into as many public sites in our community as possible to enable trained lay people to use this life-saving training and technology as needed. While the need for AED placements is great, the resources of this church body are limited. This brief application has been developed to facilitate the allocation of these precious resources.
